Dear Managers, Coaches, Parents and Friends of MLL,

The Marlboro Little League (MLL) Board of Directors fully appreciates all those that volunteer their time to help with the tasks that are performed at the complex. That said, there have been instances lately where the burden of this work seems to have fallen upon a few individuals. The MLL Complex is one of the finest, if not the finest, in the State of NJ. There is a high level of expectation, and rightfully so, with regards to how the facility is kept and run. In order to maintain this high standard we need cooperation and participation from all those that Manage and Coach within the league. This also holds true for the families and those that visit the complex. The MLL Board of Directors respectfully requests that each item below be reviewed by all and to please assist us when possible.

Garbage

All families are asked to ensure that all trash is properly disposed of within the trash cans located throughout the facility. If the containers are overflowing please do not pile on top of it where easy spillovers can occur. Many times there are water bottles and food that are left overnight on tables and in the stands. This creates an unsanitary condition and is an invite for raccoons and other animals to feed upon. While we do have a scheduled garbage pickup it does not occur on a daily basis. For those that are assigned an OD slot please make sure that the trash is not overflowing and emptied out.

Bathrooms

Marlboro Little League has a hired service that comes in to clean the bathrooms every day. However, there is no one stationed at the complex on an hourly basis to help clean them. That would become an enormous cost to the League. With the amount of traffic that we have at the complex, especially on the weekends, it is not an easy task for any individual to keep up with. Families are asked for their help in this matter and to help keep these areas as clean as possible.

Fields

Managers and Coaches must ensure that nothing is left behind in the dugouts after a game. Water bottles and any other garbage must be removed prior to leaving the dugout.

For those that use the Toro and rake the fields. Please proceed with caution. There have been instances where sprinkler heads have been damaged by this equipment. This has caused unnecessary flooding and additional costs to the league in order to repair the sprinkler system and to get the fields ready to play.

We need Managers and Coaches to arrive before the game and help get them ready. There can always be an unforeseen circumstance where a field needs attention. Today is a perfect example where the fields are probably wet from the rain last night. If it is decided to play the games this evening we need the Managers and Coaches to arrive early and help get them ready. This is especially true on the weekends. If possible, please do not show up 15 mins before game time expecting that another volunteer has the time to get the fields ready. We need assistance in this area.

Prior to the start of the season the mounds were in impeccable condition. Many of the uneven slopes and holes that now exist are directly attributed to the kids digging their cleats into the mound thinking they can gain better traction. The exact opposite is true, this only wears away at the mound creating more difficulty for them. In addition, it is costly to the league to rebuild a mound. If a Manager or Coach sees a child doing this please help put an end to it.

The Marlboro Little League thanks you for your time and cooperation. As previously mentioned the league is run by volunteers that need your support. Please help us to make this facility the best one possible.
