As a parent/guardian of a child in the MBTC program, I endorse the belief that sportsmanship counts. In keeping with the spirit of this belief, I pledge that I will do to the best of my ability, I will:

- Always do my individual best to bring a sense of civility and sportsmanship to my Childs games.

- Always conduct myself in accordance with the true spirit of "Good Sportsmanship". By accepting wins without gloating and accepting losses without complaining; and, by treating my child, his/her teammates, our opponents, game officials, all coaches, program administrators, and the game itself with respect.

I understand that as a parent /guardian of a participant in a MBTC program, my behavior at all related (games and practices) must be beyond reproach. I further understand that all instances of unacceptable behavior on my part, as well as any other violation of this code of conduct by me, is subject to review by the appropriate authorities and could result in my losing the privilege of attending further competitions. Serious violations may also run afoul of NJ State law (P.L.2002, c.74 – Athletics Codes of Conduct), and could result in criminal penalties.
